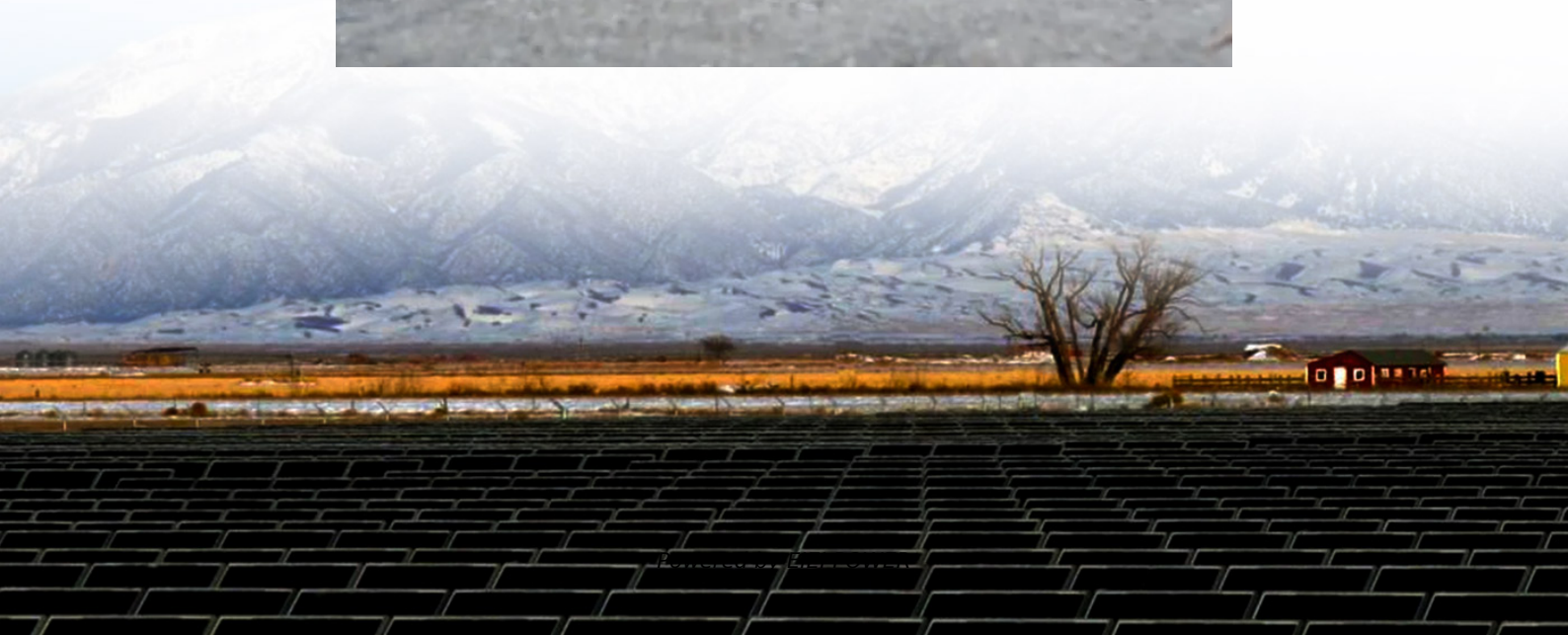

Denmark uses power outlets and plugs of types C, F, E & K. Take a look at the pictures below to see what these plugs and power sockets look like: Doesn't look familiar?

Do the outlets look different in your country?

You'll need a power plug adapter. Type C - The standard European plug.

Are there electrical outlets in Denmark?

No, the electrical outlets in Denmark are different from those in the United States. In Denmark electrical outlets of types C, F, E & K are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Denmark?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Denmark are of types C, F, E & K (see images).

What type of outlet does Denmark use?

Denmark uses outlet types C, E, F, K at a voltage of 230V and a frequency of 50 Hz. Plug Compatibility: Type C, Type E, Type F, Type K Voltage: 230V Frequency: 50 Hz Can North Americans use Electronics in Denmark without an Adapter?

No! North Americans will need an adapter for the outlets and a transformer for the voltage when traveling to Denmark.

What is the standard voltage for a power outlet in Denmark?

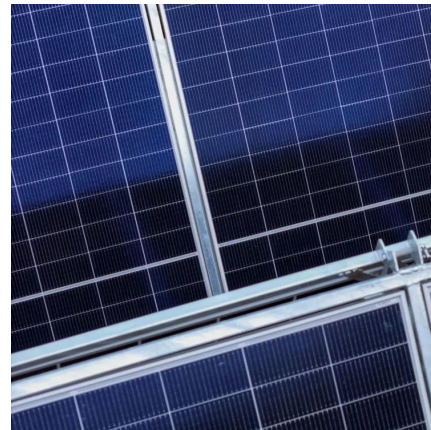
